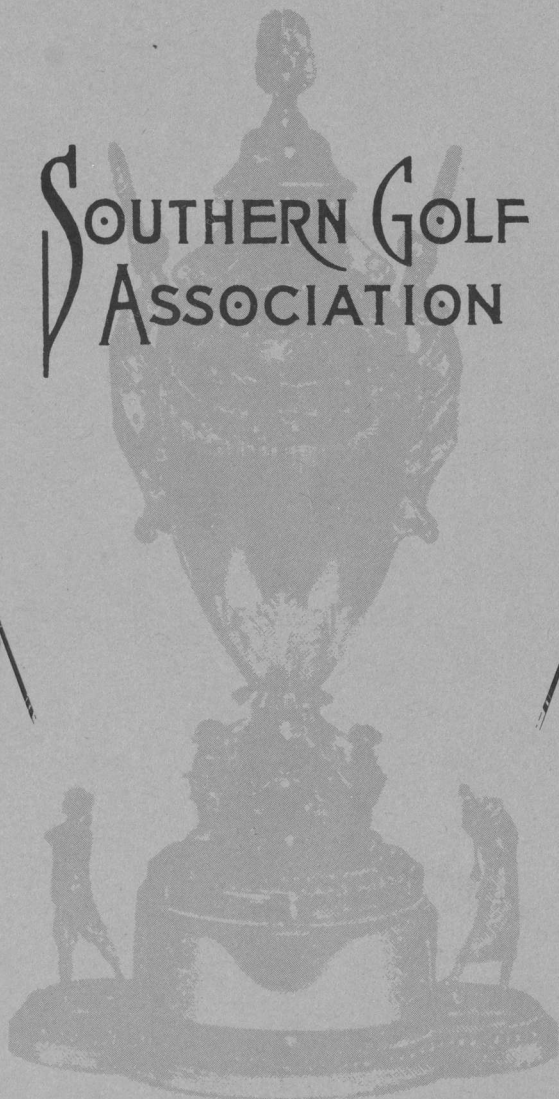
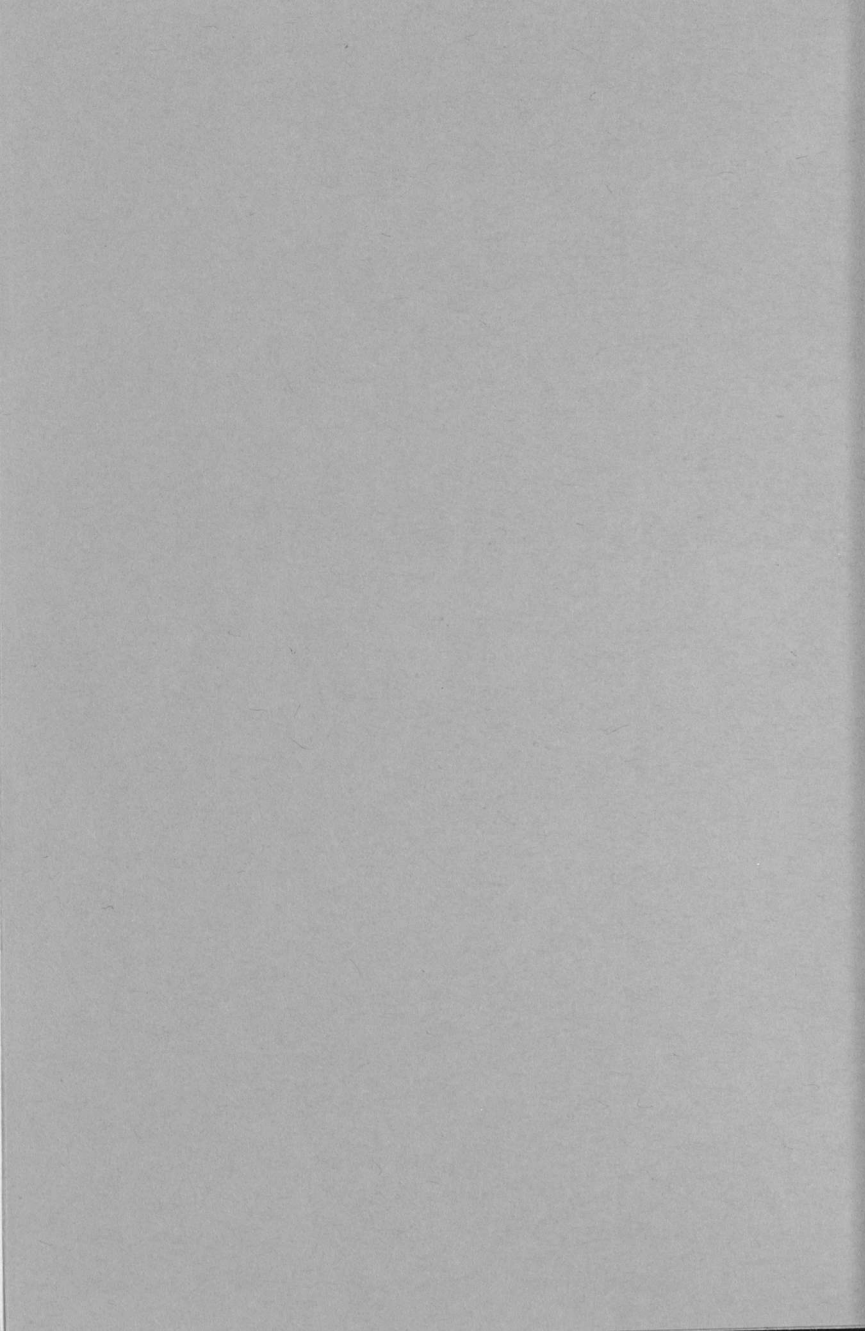

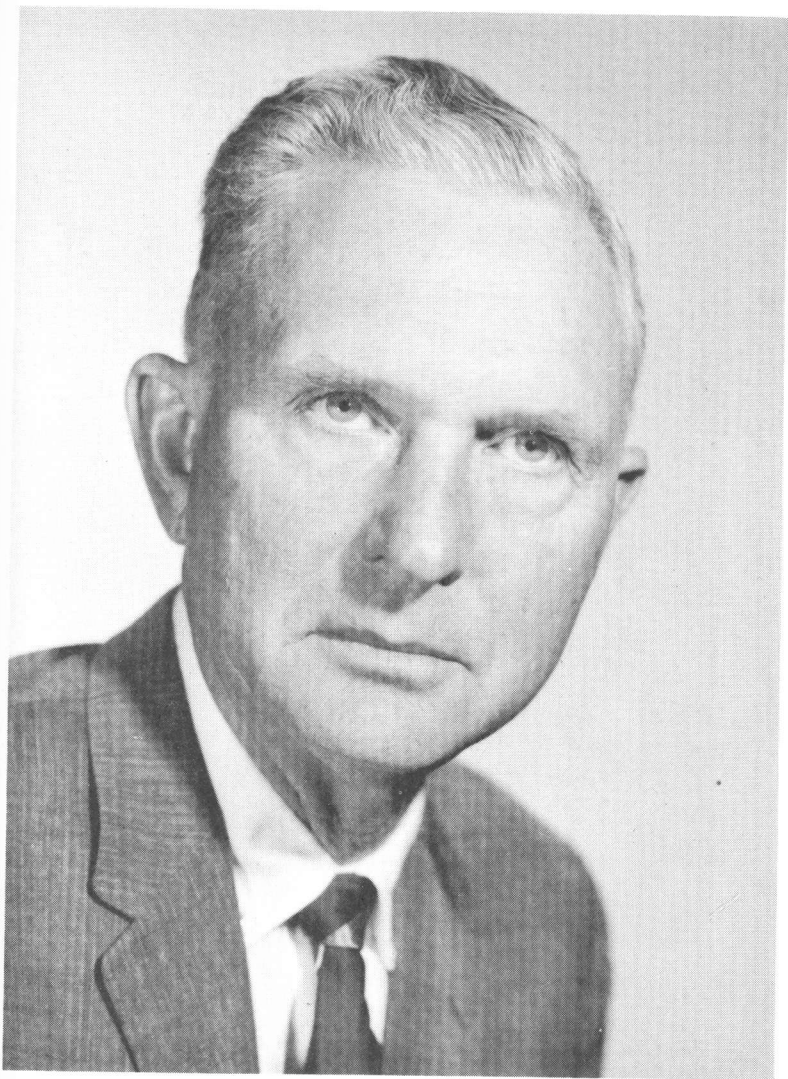

Commemorating his career in Golf and the greatest record yet achieved in the competitive phases of the game, this trophy is dedicated to

ROBERT TYRE JONES, JR.

Who was reared in and played from Atlanta, Georgia, and who in the space of fifteen years, from 1916 through 1930, played in thirty-one major championships of the United States and Great Britain, and retired at the age of 28 with this list of victories:

UNITED STATES AMATEUR, 1924, 1925, 1927, 1928,
1930.

UNITED STATES OPEN, 1923, 1926, 1929, 1930.

BRITISH OPEN, 1926, 1927, 1930.

BRITISH AMATEUR, 1930.

Additionally, he won the first Georgia State Amateur Championship in 1916 at the age of 14; won the Southern Amateur Championship in 1917, 1920, and 1922; and played as a member of the United States Walker Cup Team in 1922, 1924, 1926, 1928 and 1930, being captain in the last two meetings, and never losing a match at singles.

At his retirement from competitive Golf in 1930 his status as First Official World Champion was assured by his winning in that year the British Amateur, the British Open, the United States Open and the United States Amateur Championships, known as the Grand Slam, and thus entrenching his record safely and forever within the Impregnable Quadrilateral of Golf.

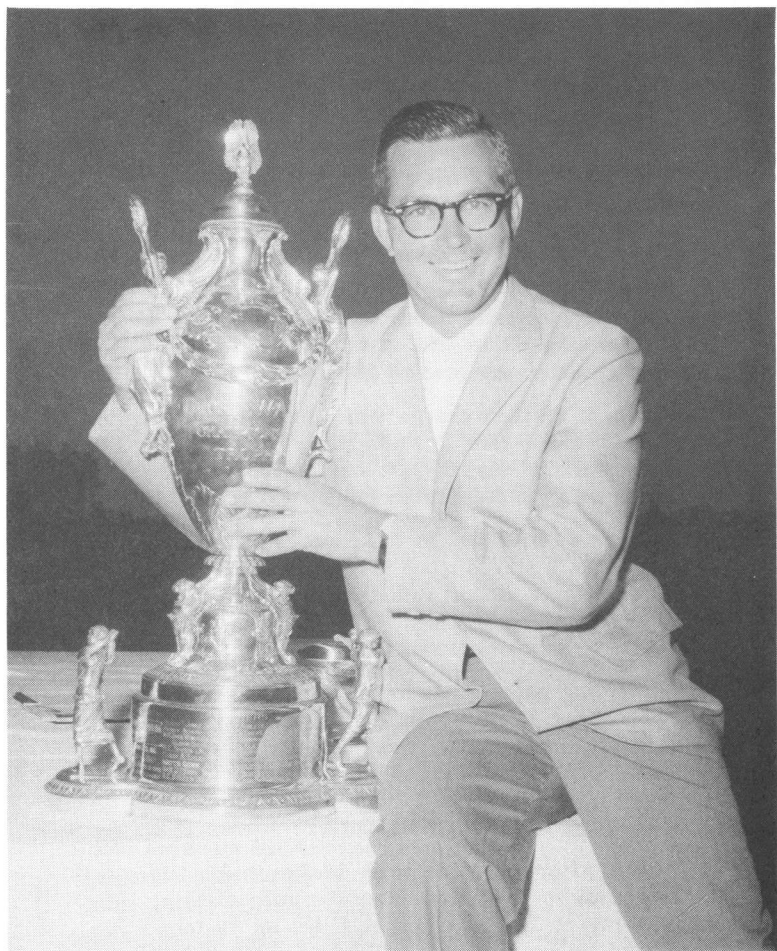

**THE FIFTY-NINTH
ANNUAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP
OF THE

PINEHURST — Stringing out magnificent tee shots with a new “old man’s driver,” Billy Joe Patton fired a brilliant closing 69 to win the Southern Amateur Golf championship by one stroke.

Victim of Patton’s charge, which included four birdies, was third-round leader Downing Gray of Pensacola, Fla. Gray started the day at 215, one under par and four shots ahead of the Morganton lumber executive.

Patton’s 34-35 ranks in the class of the amazing because Old No. 2 played much longer than its fullest 7,000 yards following a violent rainstorm that held up play for 90 minutes.

It was one of the finest rounds ever posted by Patton anywhere, and particularly on No. 2 where he previously had won three North-South championships, the last in 1963. That, incidentally, was his last major sectional triumph.

CATCHES GRAY

Patton, after recording three birdies and a bogey on the front, all accomplished after the gully-washing rain, caught Gray on No. 11 when he holed an 18-foot birdie putt. That pulled him even with par for the distance.

Then, the 43-year-old Patton, who won the 1961 Southern Amateur when it was competed at match play, took the lead when the 24-year-old Gray bogeyed the 12th. Gray played one threesome behind Patton’s.

The final 69, in which only one of Patton’s drives went

out of the fairway and that by only three feet on No. 7, gave the Tar Heel a 72-hole tally of 288, even with par and several strokes below the consensus guess at a winning score.

By winning, Patton keeps the handsome George W. Adair Memorial Trophy in North Carolina. Dale Morey of High Point brought it here last year. However, Morey had to withdraw after 36 holes this year because of illness.

Dave Smith of Gastonia rallied with a 35-35—70 that included three birdies for a 293 and third place. Jack Lewis, the 17-year-old from Florence, S.C., also registered a closing 70 and placed fourth at 294.

Smith's brother Charlie, who had opened the final round tied for second at 216, even par, soared to a 40-39—79, which included a triple-bogey-7 on No. 5 and a double-bogey-5 on No. 6.

The man who shared the 216 slot, David Boyd of Atlanta, also ran into considerable difficulty, much of it stemming from bad breaks, and struggled to a 40-40—80.

Patton explained that the new driver has an old man's shaft. "I'd been using a young man's shaft in my driver," he said. But until Saturday, the new weapon, which he acquired four-five weeks ago, had not been doing its stuff.

Patton started his charge with consecutive birdies right after play resumed following the rain. He holed an eight-footer on No. 3 and an 18-incher on No. 4. A missed-green bogey on No. 5 slowed him until he rolled in a five-footer for a deuce on No. 9.

That put him one over par for the 63 holes played, and he pulled even with par and with Gray on the 11th. From there Patton parred in, one-putting on Nos. 14, 15 and 18 to avoid bogeys.

On the 14th, Patton chipped to within three feet, then on the 206-yard 15th a 3-iron shot rolled short but he almost chipped in with a 7-iron.

The clincher came on the final hole, only moments

after Gray's six-foot birdie putt on No. 17 hit a spike mark and jumped away from the cup. Patton missed the 18th, and miss-hit a chip with a wedge, but the ball hit the cup and stopped inches away for a sure par-4.

It was a frustrating day for Gray, although he had some magnificent scrambling to thank for keeping the lead as long as he held it.

Gray, who finished second in the 1962 National Amateur to Labron Harris Jr. in his only other tournament start here, one-putted three of the first six greens, to save pars, holing one from 12 feet on No. 6. On his fourth missed green of the day, the 5-9 Pensacolan missed a 10-foot par try.

But the real story of Gray's round lies in his inability to make birdies when he had the chance.

He missed from six feet on Nos. 9 and 17, saw a short one roll over the edge of the hole on No. 16, and then ended his day with another miss, this one from 15 feet on the last hole which would have sent him and Patton into an 18-hole playoff Sunday.

The crusher for Gray was the 433-yard 12th, where he had about a 185-yard second shot. When he swung his 4-iron, the ball appeared headed for birdie range on the green.

Instead, it hit on the back of the green and bounced off. He chipped strongly, setting up an uphill putt if he missed. The ball went six feet past, and Gray missed coming back for a bogey.

To show how well Gray was chipping and putting under tremendous pressure, he one-putted successfully five times, yet none was for a birdie. Patton one-putted seven times, and netted four birdies.

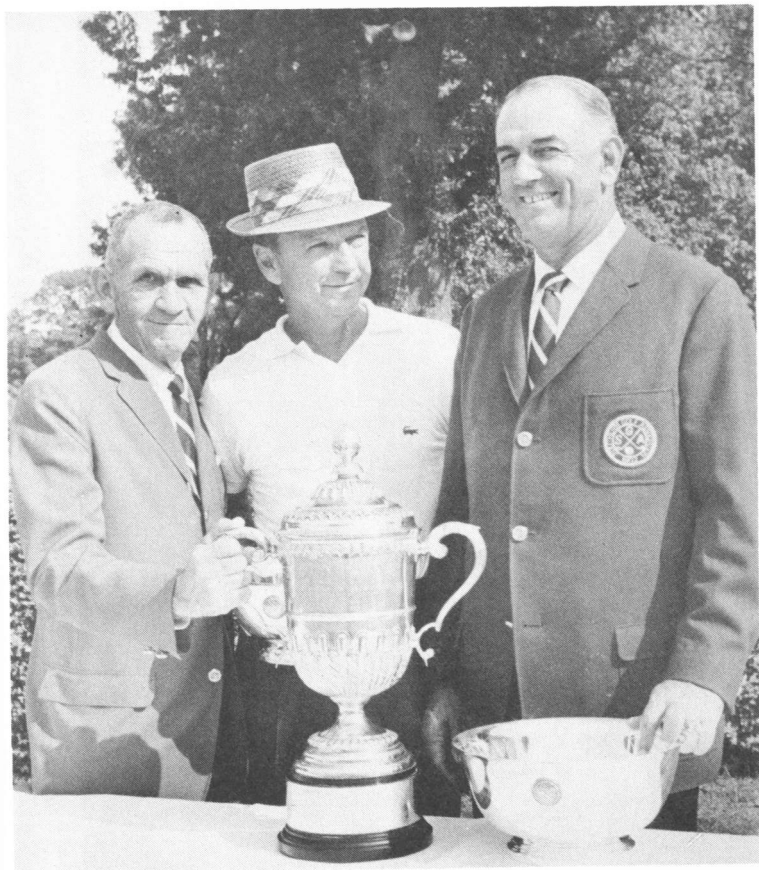

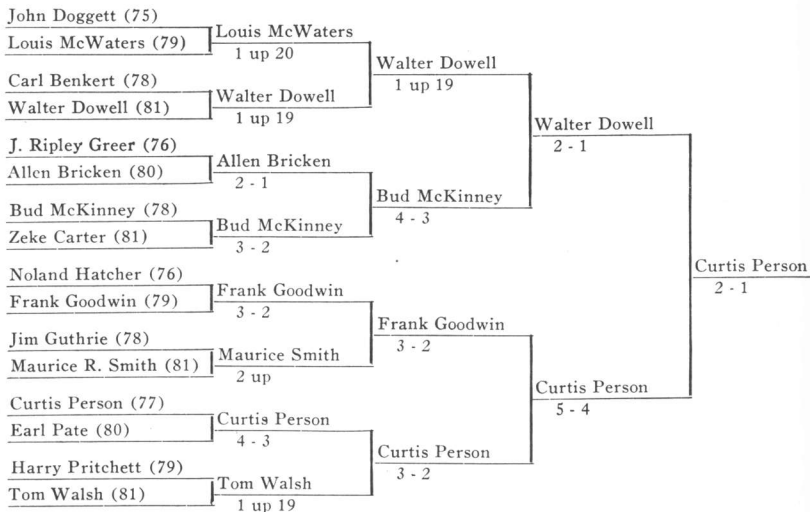

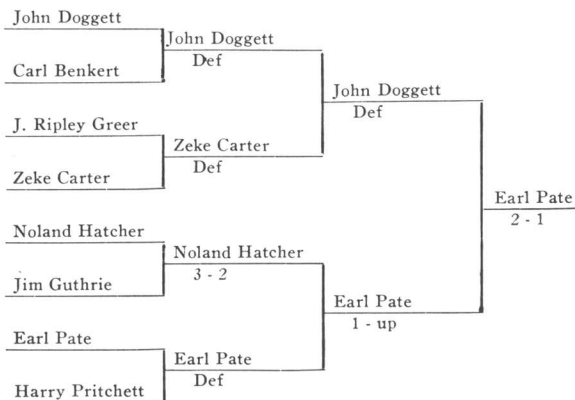

THE 1965 REVIEW OF THE SOUTHERN GOLF ASSOCIATION

As a result of the combined efforts of a very active Board of Directors under the capable direction of President David A. Perkins of Harlan, Kentucky, 1965 goes into the record books as one of the most successful years in the long and colorful history of the Southern Golf Association.

A record 292 outstanding Golf and Country Clubs from throughout the fourteen states were affiliated with the Association in 1965, a net increase of 20 clubs over the previous year.

The fifty-ninth annual SGA Championship, played over the fabulous number two course at the Pinehurst Country Club, Pinehurst, North Carolina, attracted a record entry of 270 Golfers but due to the limited field of 210 players, entries were reluctantly returned to many outstanding Golfers.

Billy Joe Patton of Morganton, North Carolina, a previous SGA Champion, emerged as the 1965 Champion with a total score of 288, even par for the 72 hole event. Runner-up with a one over par 289 was Downing Gray of Pensacola, Florida. Medalist honors and the coveted Sam Perry Medal went to Jackie Cummings of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, with a 36 hole qualifying score of 141, three strokes better than par. It was indeed unfortunate that the defending champion, Dale Morey of High Point, North Carolina became ill on the third day of play and was forced to withdraw.

The 1965 Senior Championship was played over the course of the Chickasaw Country Club in Memphis, Tennessee, Curtis Person of the Colonial Country Club in Memphis was victorious in his first outing in the Senior Ranks. Walter Dowell of Walnut Ridge, Arkansas repeated his performance as Runner-up. Captain John McCue, the defending Champion was forced to withdraw and return to New Orleans due to Hurricane Betsy.

It is always gratifying to announce that again this year, The Association is pleased to make a substantial contribution to the Mitt Jeffords Turf Research Fund, established by the Association some years ago to financially assist the program of Turf Research and Development now being conducted in Tifton, Georgia.

The 1966 Southern Amateur Championship will be played at the Country Club of Birmingham, Alabama, June 13-16, 1966, and from all indications this will be another outstanding Tournament.

Last Tree Country Club of North Palm Beach, Florida, will host the 1966 Senior Championship to be played November 7-11.

CONSTITUTION
OF THE
SOUTHERN GOLF ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I

The name of this organization shall be "The Southern Golf Association."

ARTICLE II

The object of this Association shall be to promote the game of golf, the protection of the interests of its members, the holding of such tournaments as may be decided on by the Board of Directors, and the suitable recognition of the winners in the championship or other contests.

ARTICLE III

Upon the adoption of this Constitution the Association shall consist of the following clubs:

ARTICLE IV

Any properly organized club upon whose grounds the game of golf is regularly played, and whose golf grounds are located in any of the states enumerated below, may become a member of this Association, and shall be finally admitted on an application which receives the approval of two-thirds of the Board of Directors. Any such application may, in the discretion of the Secretary and a Director of the Association, be tentatively approved by such Officers, and if so approved, the applicant shall, pending final action by the Board of Directors, have all the privileges of membership in the Association.

ARTICLE V

Applications for membership shall be made in writing to the Secretary of this Association, accompanied by such information as that officer deems necessary for the Directors to have before passing on the application. A full year's dues shall accompany the application.

ARTICLE VI

Section 1. The acceptance of membership in the Association shall bind each club to abide by all of the conditions of the Constitution, By-Laws, and Rules of the Association, and to accept and enforce all decisions which the Board of Directors is authorized to make relating to this Association's Affairs.

Sec. 2. Any member may be suspended or expelled by a two-thirds vote of all the Directors at any regular or special meeting; an appeal may be taken from such action of the directors to any regular or special meeting of the membership.

Sec. 3. No club shall be expelled or suspended without due notice, with formal charges, and an opportunity to be heard in its own defense.

ARTICLE VII

Section 1. The annual meeting of the Association shall be held during the week and at the place of the Annual Southern Championship Tournament, the exact day and hour to be fixed by the Directors of the Association, who shall give ample notice to every member.

Sec. 2. Each member shall have, at any regular or special meeting, the right to be represented (in person only) by one voting delegate or alternate.

ARTICLE VIII

As Amended Aug. 11, 1958

As Amended June 18, 1962

Section 1. At the annual meeting the Association shall elect from the membership of the clubs composing the association, a President, a First Vice-President, a Second Vice-President, and a Vice-President in charge of Senior Affairs, and a Board of Directors of not less than fifteen or more than twenty-eight members, the exact number to be fixed in the By-Laws, who shall hold office until the last day of the current year.

Sec. 2. The President and Vice Presidents shall be ex-officio members of the Board of Directors.

Sec. 3. The election of the officers and directors shall be made in such manner as the majority of the delegates may determine at the annual meeting.

ARTICLE IX

The management of the Association shall be vested in the Board of Directors. They shall, at their first meeting, elect a Secretary and a Treasurer (or they may select one person to fill both positions), fix the bonds and salaries of said officers, if any, prescribe their duties, and otherwise have entire control over the officers.

ARTICLE X

The Directors shall fix the time, place, and date of the annual or any special meeting of the Association. They shall have power to fix the program for such meetings and tournaments, or delegate such power to one or more special committees.

ARTICLE XI

The Directors may appoint such standing committees as they consider for the best interest of the Association. The President shall be ex-officio a member of all standing or special committees.

ARTICLE XII

Section 1. Meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at any time on call of the President or by written request signed by at least three Directors.

Sec. 2. Special meetings of the Association may be held at any time by order of a majority of the Directors, or by petition of at least seven members of the Association.

Sec. 3. Ten days' notice shall be given of any meetings of the Association or of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XIII

At meetings of the Board of Directors, at which the place for holding the annual tournament is to be determined, votes of absent members of the Board may be received by mail and recorded in selecting the tournament city.

A majority of the Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Southern Golf Association

ARTICLE XIV

Section 1. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Association or of the Board of Directors, and shall carry out the orders of the Directors in the management of the Association.

Sec. 2. The First Vice President shall, in the absence of the President, perform the duties of that office.

Sec. 3. The Secretary shall keep the records of the Association, give notices of all meetings, and perform such other duties as the Directors may require of him.

Sec. 4. The Treasurer shall collect all moneys belonging to the Association and disburse same under direction of the Board of Directors. He shall report in writing to the Board of Directors and the Association at each meeting of either body.

ARTICLE XV

As Amended June 18, 1962

Section 1. Each member shall pay to the Treasurer, by or before the date of the annual meeting, fifteen (\$15.00) dollars annual dues.

Sec. 2. The accounting year shall begin January 1 and end December 31, of each year.

Sec. 3. Failure to pay dues by or before the date of the annual meeting shall preclude the delinquent from representation at any meeting and debar their members from the privileges of entering any Association contest while the said Club is delinquent. If said delinquency continues for sixty days after the end of the fiscal year, the club shall be dropped from membership.

ARTICLE XVI

Amendments to this Constitution may be made at any annual or special meeting of the Association by a vote of at least two-thirds of all the votes cast, provided ten days' notice has been given of the proposed ammendment.

BY-LAWS

Section 1. The order of business at all meetings of the Association shall be as follows:

1. Roll Call.
2. Reading of minutes of previous meetings.
3. Secretary's report.
4. Treasurer's report.
5. General and new business.
6. Elections.
7. Adjournment.

Sec. 2. Each year a tournament for the amateur championship of the South shall be held under the direction and management of the Board of Directors, and suitable prizes awarded in the championship and other contests. The entrance fee in such tournaments shall be \$15.00 for each entrant. The entries shall be made in the manner prescribed by the Board of Directors.

Sec. 2-A. At each annual meeting the Board of Directors shall decide definitely upon the place where the next year's championship tournament shall be held.

Sec. 3. No player shall be eligible to compete for the championship unless he is a bona fide resident of one of the States covered by the Association and a member of a club belonging to the Association and in good standing; except that no entry shall be received from any competitor who shall not have been a member of the club from which he is entered for sixty days prior to the date of the competition unless said competitor shall be otherwise eligible by reason of his membership in some other club.

Sec. 4. All competitions shall be played strictly in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the United States Golf Association, with such special rules as the Board of Directors may adopt or authorize. All disputes shall be decided by the Board of Directors, who shall officiate as a tournament committee of this Association, and whose decisions shall be final.

Sec. 5. All complaints or disputes between club members of this Association shall be decided by those members

of the Board of Directors who in no way are connected with the disputes.

Sec. 6. Any member or person who is proved, to the satisfaction of two-thirds of the Board of Directors, to have been guilty of fraudulent, or discreditable conduct of any kind, may be, by the Board, declared to be ineligible to compete in any competition, suspended or expelled.

Sec. 7. The Board of Directors shall consist of twenty-seven members, in addition to the President and Vice Presidents.

Sec. 8. The Board of Directors shall have power, by a two-thirds vote, to alter, amend, or add to the By-Laws (as they may deem necessary), such action of the Board to be subject to review of the Association.

Sec. 9. A majority of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Sec. 10. Upon dissolution no part of the property or assets of said Association shall be distributed to its members, directors or officers, nor shall any amounts be paid to the members, directors or officers thereof for money loaned or advanced to the Association or by way of reimbursement for membership dues or otherwise. Any assets of said Association remaining after payment of all debts of said Association shall be transferred by said Association to any Corporation organized for exempt purposes substantially the same as the purposes of the Association so being dissolved.
