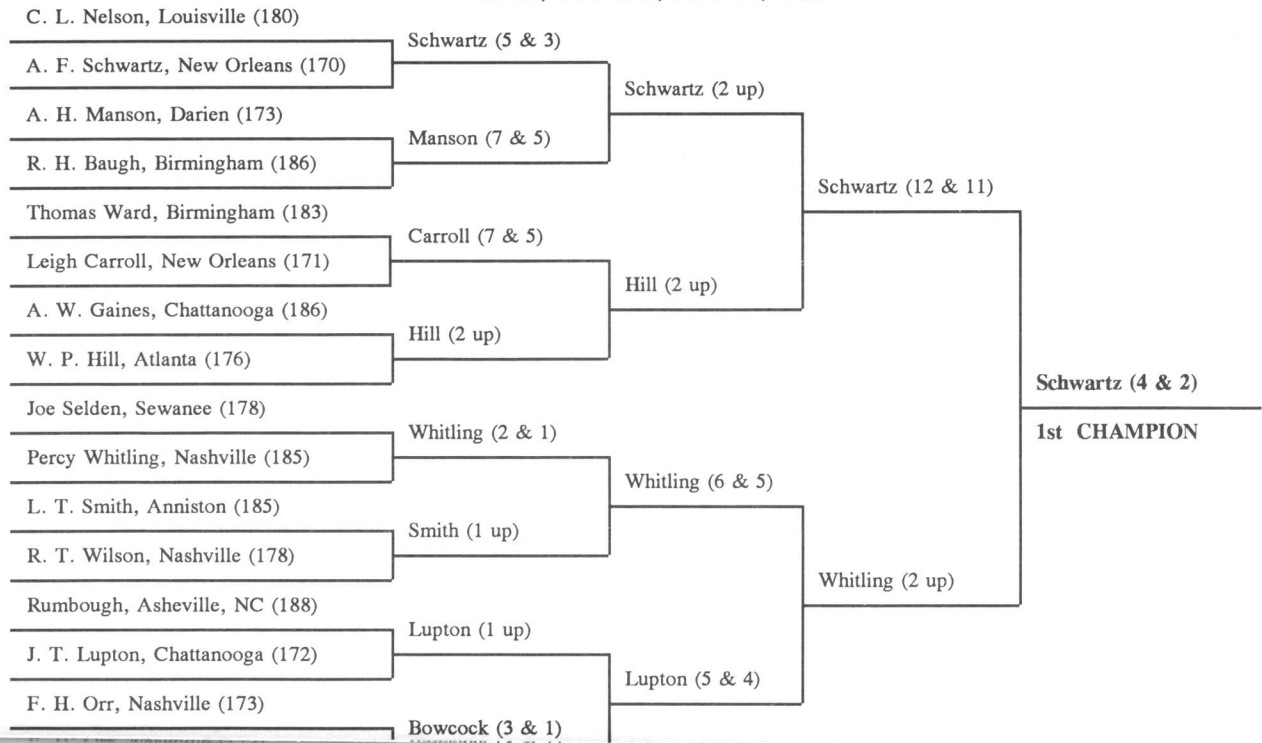

## AUSSIE CAPTURES 1995 SOUTHERN

Look for a defending champion in 1996 at the 90th Southern Amateur at the Country Club of North Carolina in Pinehurst. That's something that hasn't happened much in recent years as most of the winners turn pro before defending.

Such wasn't the case with Justin Leonard of Dallas, who won back-to-back titles in 1992 & 1993 before turning pro shortly after graduation from the University of Texas in the spring of 1994.

And such isn't the case with Lee Eagleton, a special invitee from Melbourne, Australia. After earning an impressive come-from-behind victory at Holston Hills Country Club in Knoxville, Tennessee, Eagleton said he would not turn pro until 1997 in hopes of earning a chance to represent Australia in the 1996 World Amateur Team Championship. Therefore, his plans are to return in '96 to defend.

Eagleton, 22, was among seven Australians who were in the U.S. to play the summer amateur circuit. Four received special invitations to the Southern Amateur and the other three were in the field by virtue of having played as collegians in the Southern area. Of the seven, three finished in the top 30.

Eagleton was the second non-American to win the Southern Amateur title, preceded by Mexican Rafael Alarcon, who was a student at Oklahoma State University when he won in 1979 at the Country Club of North Carolina.

At Holston Hills Country Club, Eagleton edged Paul Simson of Raleigh, North Carolina by two strokes, 274 to 276. Never far off Simson's lead, Eagleton had a final round of six under par 66 on the venerable 6,910 Donald Ross course, marking the fourth time the Southern has taken its championship to this wonderful site.

Simson, 44, led Eagleton by three, five and two strokes the first three days as he attempted to duplicate his victory earlier in the summer at the North & South Amateur at Pinehurst, another of the prestigious summer amateur events.

But in the final round, Eagleton made three consecutive birdies on the front nine to take the lead, then added four more on the back to nearly equal Simson's opening 65, the low score of the week.

P. J. Smith of nearby Morristown, Tennessee, was third at 277. U.S. Mid-Amateur champion Tim Jackson of Memphis, who won the Tennessee State Amateur at Holston Hills in 1994, was among three players tied for fourth at 279.

"It's a great thrill to win this tournament," Eagleton said. Perhaps speaking for the entire Australian contingent, he added, "We came here this summer to play in six or seven tournaments, to see how our games measure up against the Americans." Though small in numbers, at Holston Hills the Aussies measured up quite well.

Additionally, he won the first Georgia State Amateur Championship in 1916 at the age of 14; won the Southern Amateur Championship in 1917, 1920, and 1922; and played as a member of the United States Walker Cup Team in 1922, 1924, 1926, 1928 and 1930, being captain in the last two meetings, and never losing a match at singles.

At his retirement from competitive Golf in 1930 his status as First Official World Champion was assured by his winning in that year the British Amateur, the British Open, the United States Open and the United States Amateur Championships, known as the Grand Slam, and thus entrenching his record safely and forever within the Impregnable Quadrilateral of Golf.

**CHARLES HOWELL REPEATS AS SOUTHERN JUNIOR CHAMP**

The record books tell us that Charles Howell's repeat as Southern Junior Amateur Champion, a title he first won at Bayou DeSiard Country Club in Monroe, Louisiana in 1994, is not a first. Doug McLeod of Mobile, Alabama, in 1992 & 1993, and Justin Leonard of Dallas, Texas, in 1988 & 1989, both accomplished that back-to-back double previously. The intriguing scenario Howell has created is that he still has two more years of eligibility before leaving the ranks of the juniors, thus making it possible for him to be the first to win three and then possibly four.

A field of 143 entrants, representing 12 states, began play on June 13th at Cherokee Country Club in Dunwoody, Georgia to compete for the 23rd annual Southern Junior Amateur Championship. Tournament Chairman Frank Stevenson, Jr. of Atlanta, who was responsible for bringing these juniors to this wonderfully designed and manicured site, made sure these guys were presented a challenge and the scores reflected that. Entries by state were as follows:

Early attention was focused on Eward Loar of Rockwall, Texas as he came out of the blocks with a solid round of 68 and a two shot lead over three others at 70: Jay Mundy of Augusta, Georgia; Nick Cassini of Atlanta, Georgia; and Pete Abernathy of Jacksonville, Florida. Defending champion Charles Howell was far down the list with an opening 74, giving no hint of things to come.

Pete Abernathy proved that his opening 70 was no fluke as he duplicated it on Wednesday and seized the lead by two strokes over Andrew Middlebrook of Nacogdoches, Texas, who posted the day's best score of 69, and Nick Cassini, who followed his opening 70 with a second day 72. First round leader Loar struggled in with a 75 and occupied fourth at 143. Howell, regaining a measure of the form that earned him the championship in 1994, had a solid 71 to ease into the fifth place position all alone with a 144 and send a message to the field that he had best not be ignored..

The final round, the round that always tests the nerves, produced the best collection of scores as players began to figure out the best places to drive the ball and how to cope with Cherokee's difficult greens. The best round of the tournament, a 65, was shot by Howell as he stormed back to win the championship by two strokes over second round leader Pete Abernathy, who played solidly with a 72 but couldn't hold off the hard charging defending champion. Bryan Hawkins of Lufkin, Texas eased into a tie for third with first round leader Loar with a 69.

In the younger age division, which plays from the same tees as the "old" guys, Peter Rivas of New Orleans, Louisiana showed his perseverance by coming back from an opening 80 to win, posting second and final round scores of 74-77. Richard Sosebee, Jr. of Atlanta, Georgia, the leader after two rounds with scores of 75-78, had his share of problems on the final day and posted an 85 to fall back to a third place finish. Lynchburg, Virginia's Chang Kyu Hong settled down after an opening 82 and turned in 73-78 to grab second.

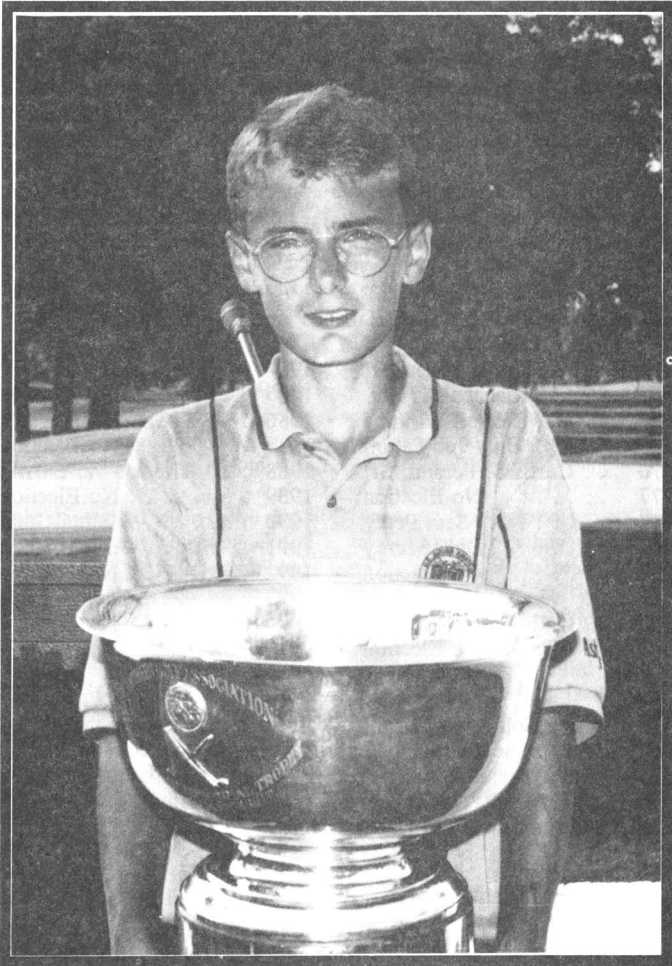

## SIMON BOLIVAR CUP

### USA TEAM REPEATS AS BOLIVAR WINNER

Fifty-six golfers from twenty-eight countries, the largest field yet for this international event, converged on the Izcaragua Golf Club in Caracas, Venezuela early in November to dispute possession of the Simon' Bolivar Cup, and as has been the case in five out of the six previous times the Cup has been contested, the USA again claimed the top prize and the cup.

Captained by Wyn Norwood of Maumelle, Arkansas, 1st Vice-President of the Southern Golf Association, the team of Tim Jackson of Memphis, Tennessee and Paul Simson of Raleigh, North Carolina, the number two and four ranked amateur players in America, cruised to victory with a tournament record margin of 23 strokes. This broke the tournament record formally held by Jay Siegel and Doug Farr of the USA set in 1985.

Although the United States won comfortably, the first two days of the event was extremely close as the Holland team of Maarten Lafeber and Robert-Jan Derksen opened with a three under team score of 137. Lurking close by was the SGA sponsored team of Jackson and Simson, in second place after posting 73 & 71 respectively for a total of 144. Lafeber's 67 was the low opening-day round.

The US started their move on the second day as Jackson turned in a two under 68, the second day medal score, to Simson's 76 while the boys from Holland struggled in with a combined team score of 150 to retain a one shot advantage. The stage was set for day three and the US to be "moving day", as the experience of Jackson and Simson took its toll on the rest of the field. With both players posting one over 71's, the US took a commanding 13 shot lead over Japan, while Holland continued their slide into a tie with Canada for third place. Low round of the day was Canada's Robert Kerr, easing around Izcaragua in 70 strokes.

Day four and the cup belonged to the US as the Americans matched 69's and overwhelmed this elite international field. Japan finished second followed by Canada, Holland, and host Venezuela.

Jackson's 281 individual total bested teammate Simson, who finished second individually, by 6 shots as the US swept individual honors also.

The Simon' Bolivar Cup was inaugurated by the Venezuelan Golf Federation to provide an outstanding contest of golf and to establish bonds between Venezuela and other countries through golf. It is staged in honor of Simon' Bolivar, the great liberator of Venezuela, Columbia, Ecuador, Peru and Bolivia. At first the cup was intended to include only the Bolivian countries and "Mother" Spain. As the years passed, however, the importance and scope of this biennial Cup competition grew beyond Bolivian borders to include most all of the great golf playing countries around the world.

The Southern Golf Association, sponsor of the US team, accepted its initial invitation in 1983 and has seen the American flag raised last in the opening ceremony and lowered last in closing, a privilege issued to the defending champion and current champion respectively. Seasoned veterans, both with years of national experience in competition, Jackson and Simson, as well as the entire US contingent, were in awe of the hospitality of the Venezuelan Golf Federation and the high standards throughout the event. We of the Southern Golf Association salute all of the Venezuelan people and federation members involved in the operation of this great international golf tournament.

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
SOUTHERN GOLF ASSOCIATION  
(Approved 1975)**

I, the undersigned, a natural person of the age of twenty-one years or more, do hereby form a non-profit corporation under the laws of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "Non-Profit Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, and to that end do hereby set forth:

**ARTICLE I  
NAME**

The name of the corporation is: SOUTHERN GOLF ASSOCIATION.

**ARTICLE II  
PERIOD OF DURATION**

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE III  
PURPOSE**

The objects and purposes of the Association shall be to promote the game of golf, to protect the interest of its members, to hold such tournaments as may be decided upon by the Board of Directors, and to suitably recognize the winners in the Championship or other contests. The Association shall be empowered to engage primarily in activities which accomplish one or more of such exempt purposes specified in Section 501(c)(3).

**ARTICLE IV  
MEMBERSHIP**

Membership in the Association shall be open to any regularly organized golf club in the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Mississippi, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia, whether or not incorporated, which endorses the objects and purposes of the Association and abides by its Articles of Incorporation bylaws, and such rules and regulations as may be established from time to time. A regularly organized golf club is a club which is composed of individual dues paying members who manage their own affairs and operate permanently at one golf course which they need not control. Upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation, the initial membership shall consist of those clubs named on the Roster of membership attached hereto.

**ARTICLE V  
DIRECTORS**

The management of the affairs, property and policies of the Association shall be vested in a Board of Directors. The number, terms, qualifications and method of election of Directors shall be set forth in the bylaws.

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors shall be thirty-nine (39).

**ARTICLE VI  
REGISTERED OFFICE**

The address of the initial registered office of the Association is Suite 3500, ONE NCNB PLAZA, Charlotte, North Carolina 28280, and the address of the initial registered agent at such address is Richard E. Thigpen, Jr.

**ARTICLE VII  
NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION**

The Association is a non-profit organization, no part of the capital or net earnings of which shall inure to the benefit of any member or any private individual. Upon the dissolution of the Association, any assets remaining after payment of all debts and obligations shall be distributed to the United States Golf Association provided it has retained its exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. In the event the exempt status of the United States Golf Association has been revoked the assets of the Association shall be distributed to an organization or organizations exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, which organization or organizations are not within the definition of a private foundation under Section 509 of the Internal Revenue Code.

**BYLAWS  
OF  
SOUTHERN GOLF ASSOCIATION**

**ARTICLE I  
Membership**

**Section 1. Qualification for Membership.** Membership in the Association shall be open to any regularly organized golf club in the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Mississippi, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia, whether or not incorporated, which endorses the objects of the Association and abides by its Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, and such rules and regulations as may be established from time to time. As used herein, "any regularly organized golf club" means a permanent golf club composed of individual dues paying members who manage their own affairs through officers and committees whom they select. Such clubs shall operate permanently at one golf course which its members have the right to play but said club need not control the course where it plays.

**Section 2. Application for Membership.** Application for membership shall be made in writing to the Secretary of the Association, in such form and accompanied by such information as the Secretary deems necessary for the Board of Directors to have before passing on such application. Dues for one (1) full year shall accompany the application.

**Section 3. Election to Membership.** Election to membership shall be by the favorable vote of two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors present at any regular or special meeting at which such application is considered.

**Section 4. Suspension or Expulsion of Members.** Except as provided in Section 5, below, a member may be suspended or expelled from the Association with or without cause by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the Board of Directors present in person.

**Section 5. Dues.** The Board of Directors shall fix the annual dues, which shall be payable prior to the Annual Meeting of the Association. Members of the club whose dues are not paid by that time shall be barred from entering all Association events during the period of delinquency. Any member whose annual dues are unpaid for sixty (60) days after the end of the fiscal year shall be automatically dropped from membership in the Association.

**ARTICLE II  
Membership Meetings**

**Section 1. Annual Meeting.** The Annual Meeting of the Association shall be held during the week and at the place of the annual Southern Championship Tournament, the exact day and hour to be fixed by the President of the Association. The Secretary of the Association shall give at least fourteen (14) days notice thereof to each member.

The order of business at the Annual Meeting shall be as follows:

**ARTICLE II (con't)**

**Section 2. Special Meetings.** A special meeting of the Association may be held on call of the President or by written request directed to the Secretary and signed by a majority of the Board of Directors, provided that at least ten (10) days written notice thereof is given to each member. Such notice shall contain a statement of the purposes of the subject meeting.

**Section 3. Representation.** At any regular or special meeting of the Association, each member shall have the right to be represented, but in person only, by one voting delegate or alternate.

**Section 4. Quorum.** At any regular or special meeting of the Association those representative of members, present in person, shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business that may come before the meeting.

**ARTICLE III  
Board of Directors**

**Section 1. General Powers and Duties.** The management of the affairs, property and policies of the Association shall be vested in the Board of Directors.

**Section 2. Number, Term, and Qualification.** The Board of Directors shall consist of the President, the First Vice President, the Second Vice President and a Vice President in charge of Senior Affairs and a Vice President in charge of Junior Affairs and not less than twenty-five (25) nor more than forty-five (45) other directors. All directors shall hold office through the next annual meeting of the Association or until their successors are duly elected and qualified. All members of the Board of Directors shall be members in good standing of a member club of the Association.

**Section 3. Election.** Directors shall be elected at the Annual Meeting of the member clubs by a vote of a majority of the voting delegates present in person. All vacancies in the Board of Directors may be filled by the remaining Directors, at any regular or special meeting, by the vote of the majority of the Directors in a meeting at which a quorum is present. The Director thus elected to fill any vacancy shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the members and until a successor is elected and qualified.

**Section 4. Meetings.** The Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held immediately following the Annual Meeting of the Association. In addition, special meetings may be called by or at the written request of the President or any three Directors. The person authorized by the Board to give notice of special meetings of the Board may designate the place, for the holding of any special meeting.

**Section 5. Notice.** Written notice of annual and special meetings of the Board shall be given to each Director at least ten (10) days in advance of said meeting. However, such notice may be waived as provided in these Bylaws. The business to be transacted at annual meetings need not be specified in the notice of such meetings, unless specifically required by law or by these Bylaws. Notice of a special meeting shall set forth the purpose for which the meeting is called.

**Section 6. Quorum.** Those Directors in attendance shall constitute quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting. Unless otherwise required by charter or statute, the act of a majority of the Directors present at any properly convened meeting at which there is a quorum shall be deemed the act of the Board.

**Section 7. Directors Emeritus.** At any annual meeting, the Board of Directors, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present in person, may elect Directors Emeritus to serve for life and those so elected shall have seat and voice on the Board of Directors by no vote.

**ARTICLE III (con't):**

**Section 8. Associate Directors.** The President shall have the authority to appoint associate Directors for terms not to exceed one (1) year, and those so appointed shall have seat and voice by no vote.

**Section 9. Committees.** The Board of Directors may establish such standing or other committees as they consider proper or for the best interests of the Association and the membership of all such committees shall consist of those persons appointed by the President. The President of the Association shall ex-officio be a member of all committees.

**Section 10. Rules.** The Board of Directors shall make all rules governing the conduct and management of the Association which it deems advisable and which are not in conflict with the purpose of the Association or its Bylaws.

**Section 11. Compensation.** Directors shall receive no salary for their services.

**ARTICLE IV  
Waiver of Notice**

Whenever, under the laws of the State of North Carolina or by provision of these Bylaws, a waiver in writing is signed by persons entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, it shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

**ARTICLE V  
Officers**

**Section 1. Officers and Terms.** The officers of the Association shall be a President, a First Vice President, a Second Vice President, a Vice President for Senior Affairs, a Vice President for Junior Affairs, an Executive Secretary, a Field Secretary, a Treasurer, and such other officers as may be elected by the Board of Directors. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be merged into the single office of Secretary-Treasurer at the discretion of the Board of Directors. Each officer shall hold office for one year or until his successor is elected and qualified.

**Section 2. Vacancies.** Vacancies in an office may be filled by the Directors at any regular or special meeting.

**Section 3. Election and Removal.** Any officer may be elected or removed without cause by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Directors present in person at a regular or special meeting.

**Section 4. President.** The President shall preside at all meetings of the members and of the Board, shall be the chief executive officer of the Association, and shall have general supervision and management of the affairs of the Association subject, however, to the control, when exercised, of the Board of Directors. He shall make reports to the Directors and members and perform all such other duties as are incident to this office or are properly required of him by the Board of Directors.

**Section 5. First Vice President.** The First Vice President shall perform all such duties as may be properly required of him by the Board of Directors or the President and, in the absence or inability of the President, shall exercise and perform the functions and exercise all the powers of the President.

**ARTICLE V, Section 4 (con't):**

**Section 6. Second Vice President.** The Second Vice President, in the absence of the First Vice President, shall perform the duties of that office.

**Section 7. Vice President for Senior Affairs.** The Vice President for Senior Affairs shall be responsible primarily for all functions of the Association sponsored for seniors.

**Section 8. Vice President for Junior Affairs.** The Vice President for Junior Affairs shall be responsible primarily for all functions of the Association sponsored for juniors.

**Section 9. Executive Secretary.** The Executive Secretary shall: keep minutes of the meetings of the Directors and members; have charge of the books and records; receive and disburse all funds; provide the Treasurer with accounts of all transactions concerning the financial condition of the Association; receive and process all membership applications and entries for tournaments; be responsible for making arrangements for tournaments and assisting in the conduct of competitions; perform such other duties as are incident to his office or are properly required of him by the Board of Directors or the President.

**Section 10. Field Secretary.** The Field Secretary shall make such reports and perform such duties as are incident to his office or are properly required of him by the Board of Directors or the President.

**Section 11. Treasurer.** The Treasurer shall have custody of all monies and securities of the Association and shall keep regular books of account. He shall disburse the funds of the Association as may be ordered by the Board of Directors or the President, and shall render an account of all his transactions as Treasurer, and of the financial condition of the Association, and shall perform all duties incident to his office or that are properly required of him by the Board of Directors or the President. He shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of his duties in such sums and with such securities as the Board of Directors shall from time to time determine. He shall report in writing to the Board of Directors and the members of the Association at the meeting of each body.

**Section 12. Compensation.** The salaries, if any, of the employees and officers shall be fixed by the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE VI**

**Annual Championship Tournament and Other Tournaments**

**Section 1. Tournaments.** Each year a tournament for the Amateur Championship of the South shall be held under the direction and management of the Board of Directors, or such committees as they may designate, and suitable prizes shall be awarded in the championship. In addition, the Association shall conduct such other tournaments as the Board of Directors may determine from time to time. The Board shall determine the method of play in such tournaments or delegate such power or any part thereof to any duly established committee.

**Section 2. Site.** The Board shall select the sites for all tournaments sponsored by the Association. The site of the succeeding years' championship shall be determined at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors.

**Section 3. Entry Fees.** The entry fee for the championship tournament and all other tournaments shall be determined by the Board of Directors. The entries shall be made in the manner prescribed by the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE VI, Section 1 (con't):**

**Section 4. Eligibility.** No player shall be eligible to compete in a championship tournament unless: (1) he is a bona fide member of a club belonging to the Association and in good standing, and has been a member of the club from which he is entered for sixty (60) days prior to the date of the championship competition unless said competitor shall be otherwise eligible by reason of his membership in some other club; or (2) has competed within the calendar year of the tournament in which he is entered as a member of a golf team of a college or university located within one of the states named in Article 1, Section 1, which team represents said school in regularly scheduled intercollegiate golf competition; or (3) has received an invitation from a special committee of former Southern Golf Association Presidents who shall have the right, but not the obligation, to invite one or more competitors of national or international standing who are not otherwise eligible to compete in the southern Golf Association Championship. Any person who is proved, to the satisfaction of two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting to have been guilty of fraudulent act or other discreditable conduct of any kind, may be declared by the Board of Directors to be ineligible to compete in any competition, suspended or expelled.

**ARTICLE VII  
Rules of Tournaments**

All tournament competition shall be played strictly in accordance with the rules of golf approved by the United States Golf Association with such local rules as the Rules Committee of this Association may adopt or authorize. All other disputes shall be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.

**ARTICLE VIII  
Disputes Between Member Clubs**

All complaints and disputes between member clubs of this Association shall be decided by the Board of Directors, excluding representatives of any member club involved in the dispute being considered.

**ARTICLE IX  
Amendments**

The Board of Directors shall have the power to make, amend and repeal the Bylaws of this Association by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Directors present at any regular or special meeting of the Board. Such action of the Board shall be subject to review by the members of the Association.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Southern Golf Association, since its founding in 1902, has conducted its affairs in such manner as to promote the game of golf; and

**WHEREAS**, the Southern Golf Association has sponsored championships which have produced players of regional, national, and international fame who have been a credit to the game of golf; and

**WHEREAS**, the Southern Golf Association has trained and provided administrators for the game of golf who have enhanced the game at all levels, both regional, national, and international; and

**WHEREAS**, the Southern Golf Association has supported turf research, sponsored scholarships and by other means has made more meaningful and worthwhile the game of golf for all golfers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Southern Golf Association recognizes the international language of sports and particularly the game of golf; and

**WHEREAS**, the Southern Golf Association desires to increase its support of golf on the international level and to promote, through the game of golf, better international relations and a better understanding among people around the world;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Southern Golf Association does hereby endorse the development of a people-to-people relationship at the international level through the promotion of the game of golf and international, amateur competition to the end that international goodwill and understanding might be strengthened; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the officers of the Southern Golf Association are hereby authorized and directed to implement those programs deemed reasonable to achieve the objectives of this Association.
